## DIGITAL WAY MPIO-DMK MP3 Player!

Introduced to the Asian market last year by Korean company **Digit@I Way Ltd.**, this MP3 flash player quickly became the number one selling MP3 Player in Japan and Korea. The design is modern, simple and most of all, easy to use.

One of the smallest MP3 players yet to be introduced to the market, the MPIO- DMK is about the *size of a lipstick or key holder*, weighs only **29 grams** and can be comfortably held inside the palm of your hand, latched on the provided belt-clip or worn around the user neck as a necklace to allow users to enjoy over 2 hours of music.

It connects through the usb interface. It runs on one AAA battery and can display track information in several languages including English, Spanish, German, Japanese, Korean, Chinese and French.

This is what one user had to say: "**Kills any other player in the gym**"

"I have only had bad experiences with mp3 players in the gym... until the DMK. Finally here is a player that is stable (never crashes), stores a ton of songs (more than 30), doesn't get in the way when you work out thanks to its size, and gets loud enough without distortion to hear it in a loud environment. This player has everything that would want in an mp3 player for the active person."

Both PC and Mac compatible, the DMK includes such features as USB support for quick download speed of 5.5 Mbps and backlit LDC.

Don't click on banner ads supported by DoubleClick and don't provide credit card information to websites that are not behind a firewall. The URL should reflect https: meaning it is a secure site. -editor
