## ... The Digital Home

### Looking for a PIANO?

For **\$333,000** you can treat yourself to a state-of-the art high-tech piano with a touch-screen monitor, voice activation, and other "gadgets".

**Yamaha's Disklavier Pro 2000**, the world's most expensive piano, is built around an Intel Pentium III computer chip.

The piano's functions can be controlled by a user's voice. The user can watch an artist's performance stored on a **built-in DVD player**, while the keys and pedals move up and down, re-creating the piano part.

The sleek piano is built by hand at a plant in Hamamatsu, Japan and takes seven months to build. It has brushed aluminum legs and key cover and a transparent lid that resembles gossamer wings.

The **highest-price ever paid for a piano was the Alma-Tadema Steinway built in 1883 for Henry Marquand**, a businessman and the second president of the Metropolitan Museum of Art.

After Mr. Marquand's purchase, the piano was sent to London to be decorated by a team of artists and craftsmen.

**In 1997 the piano was auctioned by Christie's in London and sold for \$1.2 million.** "The piano has become one of our most popular objects." said curators of the Art Institute that bought it.
